Safety Guidelines and Policies regarding COVID-19

First United Methodist Church of Weatherford (FUMCW) recognizes that there is currently a COVID-19 pandemic around the world, and that there are COVID-19 cases in our county. FUMCW institutes the following measures in an effort to prevent individuals from contracting the COVID-19 virus while participating (in person) at our campus. However, FUMCW cannot be responsible if an individual contracts COVID-19 while at this location.

First United Methodist Church will continue monitoring updates and guidelines put forth by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the Texas Education Agency (TEA), and federal, state, and local officials related to COVID-19.

As a reminder, the CDC always recommends everyday preventive actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses, including:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

Participation (in person) Policies:

All parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring that a daily self-screening of each student occurs prior to coming in person.

SCREENER:

Temperature Check (temp must be less than 100°F)

Questions:

1. **Have you been exposed to anyone who is sick?**
2. **Have you had any of the following symptoms?**
 - **Cough**
 - **Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing**
 - **Chills**
 - **Shaking with Chills**

- Muscle Pain
- Headache
- Sore Throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Congestion/Runny Nose
- Feeling feverish or having a fever greater than 100 degrees Fahrenheit
- Known contact with someone who has a lab confirmed case of COVID-19.

Face Coverings:

- **Following federal, state and local mandates, the use of non-medical grade face covering will be enforced at all times.**
- **Face coverings will be required for all volunteers and students 4th grade and up.**
- **Students in 4th grade and up (health exceptions) are required to use non-medical grade face coverings, covering nose and mouth at all times.**
- **Parents/ Guardians will be required to use non-medical grade face coverings, covering nose and mouth for drop off and pick up of students.**

In accordance with guidance from the White House, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and our Central Texas Conference of the United Methodist Church, FUMCW will follow the guidelines for sanitation, disinfecting, and social distance to ensure the safest possible environment.

In consideration of joining us in person, by your signature below, you are stating that you will follow these guidelines and understand the policies will be enforced.

I hereby waive any rights and assume all risks of contracting COVID-19 at this location, and further release, indemnify, defend, and forever discharge First United Methodist Church of Weatherford, its staff, employees, volunteers and representatives from any and all liability if I contract the COVID- 19 virus while at this location.
